Some are based in schools, and others are known as visiting Teachers of the Deaf



Teachers of the Deaf provide essential support for students and their family and often liaise with other professionals involved with the child's hearing loss like audiologists and speech pathologists




Teachers of the Deaf are well educated on how to aid students with various disabilities in addition to hearing loss
